- Réactiver et utiliser les connaissances et le lexique des élections américaines.
- Favoriser une situation de communication authentique (information gap » / recherche de ce que l'on ne connaît pas).
- Dépasser la peur de faire des erreurs, de ne pas comprendre et celle de ne pas être compris.
- Développer l'autonomie et l'implication de tous les élèves.
- Modifier le rythme de la séquence et relancer l'intérêt des élèves.
- Permettre aux élèves de s'approprier l'action et accroître le temps de parole de chacun.

-  80 -100 cards with **a word to guess** and **5 taboo words** that may not be spoken



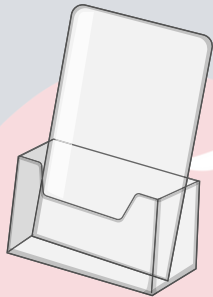

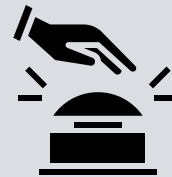

- Tray for holding cards (optional)













- Timer (in the form of a one-minute hourglass)



- Buzzer or squeaker
- Pencil and paper for scorekeeping



RULES

- Choose your **team** and your teammates (max 10 / team).
- A "**clue giver**" explains words to the teammates which they have to guess **WITHOUT** mentioning the **taboo words**.
- A " **censor** " (a player from the other team) makes sure you don't say one of the *taboo* words.  
- If you use a *taboo* word, the " censor " hits the buzzer and you must move on to the next word. 
- Each correct guess = 1 point. 
- Wrong guesses = no penalties. 
- Each taboo word spoken = 1 penalty. 
- You have 3 minutes to try to get as many words as possible . 
- If the word is too difficult, cards may also be " passed ." 
- When time runs out, player passes to the next player of the other team.

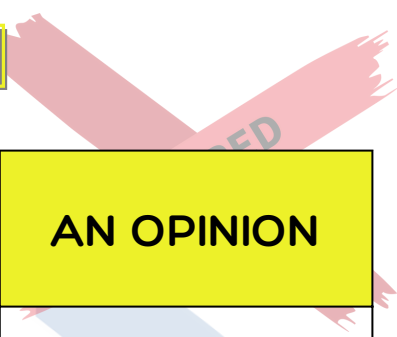
