

Rules

- Each player requires a counter on the start position.
- Each game requires dice, although a coin could be used as a substitute.
- The object of the game is to move from the start square to the finish square.
- Each player rolls their dice moving incrementally up the board.
- If a player lands on a square at the foot of a pair of ladders, they are permitted to climb to the square at the top of the ladders.
- If a player lands on the head of a snake, they slide down to the square at its tail.
- Players who land on a square with a question/task, must answer before completing their go.


