



COLLABORATIVE GUIDE TO THE 2024 US PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS



OBJECTIVES

Help students dive into the US presidential elections and understand the process that leads to the election of the leaders of the country.



SKILLS

- Research skills: reading, listening, explaining to others (mediation).
- Presentation skills: ability to show understanding of complex information and to present them in a simple way.



INSTRUCTIONS

As a class, you are going to prepare a digital guide to help your schoolmates understand the US presidential election process. You will work in groups on a topic: the candidates, the main political parties, the Electoral College, the process. You will be given some links to check but feel free to investigate on your own. Just be sure to use updated and reliable sources.



Step 1

Do some research and study the topic with your team. Then discuss together to determine the most important facts you will share with the community.



Step 3

Go to the canva template to create your slides (2 maximum). Choose the layout, photos, illustrations, infographics...



Step 2

Organize your notes. Your presentation must be easy to understand. You may add a glossary for difficult words.



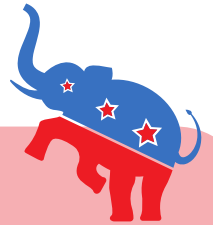
Step 4
