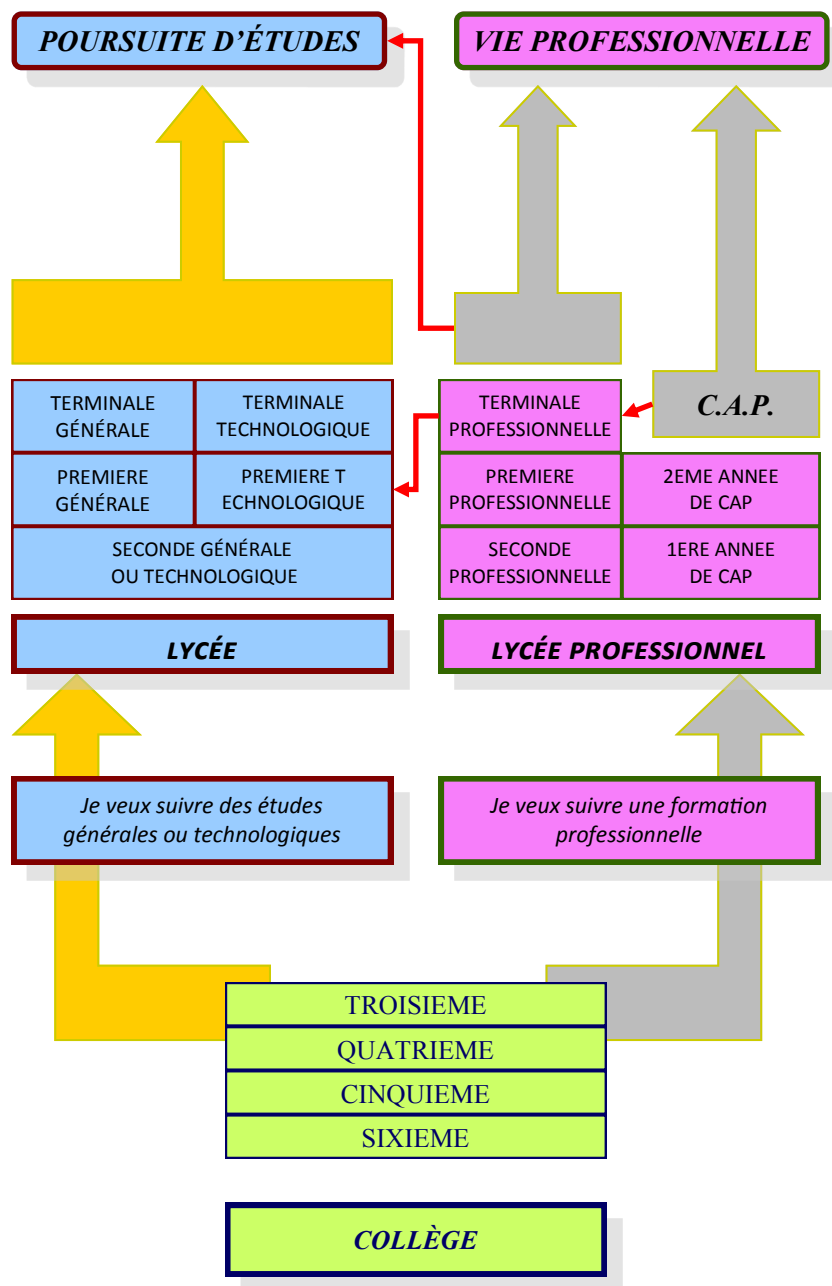

What steps to take to enrol your child?

In the middle school (“collège”)

- **Step 1:** Enrolment of the child through the DIVISAC (Vice-rectorate of Dothérame)
- **Step 2:** Tests of location in the CASNAV and in the middle school
- **Step 3:** Order of affectation transmitted to the parents or relatives by the DIVISAC
- **Step 4:** Integration into UPE2A with support FLE / FLSco in ordinary class according to the results of the positioning tests

What is your role as parents?

In the French school system, according to the principle of coeducation, parents are considered as partners.

What is your role as parents?

You can :

- Express your opinion (elections of parents to sit at the school administration board)
- Meet a professor (with an interpreter if you do not speak French)
- Make requests regarding the orientation of your child

You must :

- Watch the attendance of your child at school (presence and punctuality)
- Verify the homework and school reports
- Watch the presentation of your child (hygiene and clothes)
- Know the internal rules of the school and abide by them
- Participate in the meetings



Who can take care of your child?

Pedagogy and social skills

- The head teacher, the person in charge of the middle school (college)
- The French teacher the UPE2A (Educational Unit to Teach French to Non-French speaking newcomers (Unité Pédagogique pour les Elèves Allophones Arrivants)
- The French teacher of the ordinary class
- The class teacher, the referent of the ordinary class
- The chief supervisor (CPE)
- The “Relay Adult” for the recently arrived pupils
- The social worker
- The nurse
- the school doctor

Orientation

- The guidance counselor Psychologist (COPS) for the questions concerning the orientation of the child to the middle school(college)
