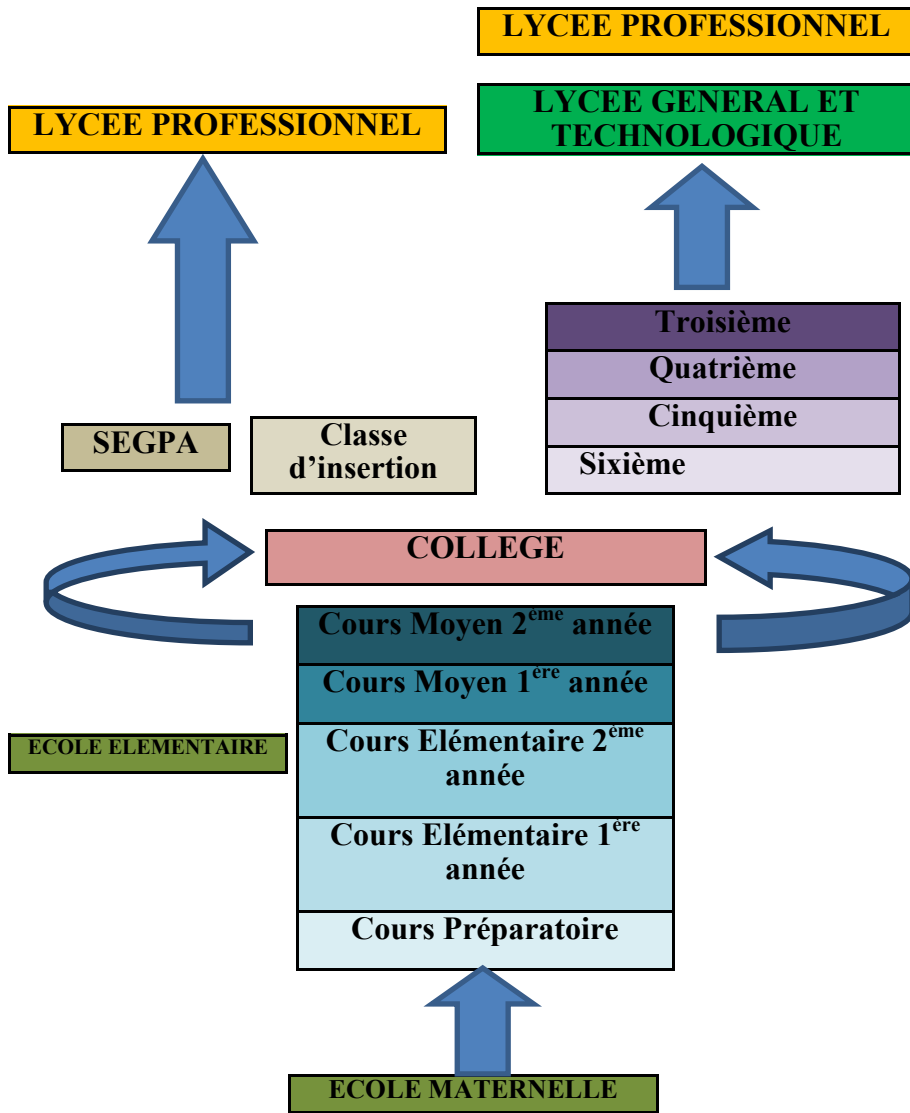

What steps to take to enrol your child?

In the primary school

- **Step 1:** Application for registration at the city hall of your place of residence
Tests of location in the CASNAV and in the school
- **Step 2:** Test of location in the CASNAV and in school
- **Step 3:** According to the results obtained tests location, registration if UPE2A exist in school

What is your role as parents?

In the French school system, according to the principle of coeducation, parents are considered as partners.

You can :

- Express your opinion (elections of parents to sit at the school administration board)
- Meet a professor (with an interpreter if you do not speak French)
- Make requests regarding the orientation of your child

You must :

- Check the school attendance of your child (presence and punctuality)
- Maintain a climate of mutual respect with the school staff
- Verify the homework and school reports of your child
- Know the rules of the school (lessons, evaluation exercise)
- Ensure your child has daily hygiene and proper clothes in accordance with the school dress code
- Participate in the meetings with teachers

Pedagogy and social skills

- The principal, the person in charge of the primary school
- The teacher of the UPE2A (Educational Unit to Teach French to Non-French speaking newcomers)
- The teacher of the class
- The school psychologist
- Le Réseau d'aide
- The social worker
- the school doctor
- The nurse

Orientation

- The teaching team composed of the school teachers
- The educative team for specific situations
