Jean Michel was a New York born halfhalf Puerto Rican artist . He hooked up at Andy Warhol and all through it he brilliant cryptic but powerful art that still resonates.

Back in the day, Jean Michel was more a street legend you know, not accepted into the mainstream. There was an element of danger in New York City in the 80s.It's what we now look back on as edge.

He wasn't just an artist that just painted on theand went home you know and slept and woke up and made breakfast. He was in the street he was in the clubs he was like a CBGB. He was rolling Madonna. Jean Michel was part of a duo named SAMO that used to graffiti weird and eerie and interesting little sayings on buildings . He was a manufactured artist.

As a solo artist he did amazing work that incorporated social commentary ,voodoo elements all different aspects of the culture. He would comment on power, comment on racism. In the 80s black culture was becoming much more noticed by the white mainstream thanks to things like hip hop music and breakdancing.

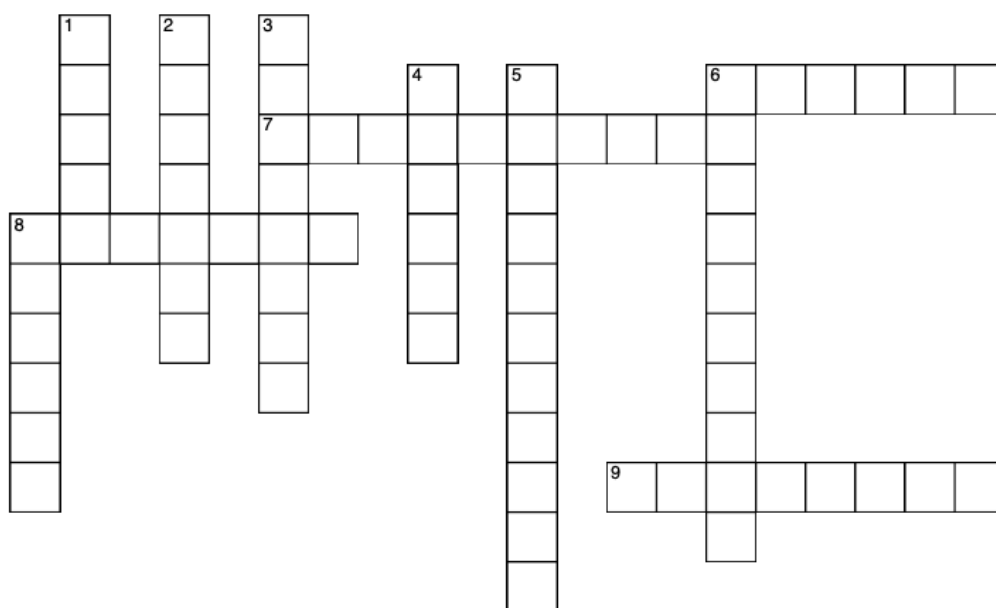
