Exemples de productions attendues :

 This document is another painting by Norman Rockwell. We can see a family. Everybody looks very happy. All the generations are represented : grandparents - parents - kids - babies. In the middle of the painting there is a man. We see him from the back. He's weighed down with presents and a suitcase. A woman is holding him in her arms. She looks very happy. They are all well-dressed. We can imagine that he was absent for a longtime and he's back for Christmas. The colors red and the green are dominant. The gifts wrap and the Christmas tree at the top right hand corner reveal that it must be Christmas time/ Eve.
