You have 60 minutes to complete as many challenges as possible. You must stay with your group, be respectful and take photo or video proof for each task.

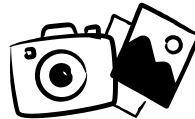


1) Canterbury City Challenge

2) Photo Challenge with a Passer-by

3) Interview a Local

Your group must interview one local person, shop worker or visitor information staff member. Ask 3 short questions, record the conversation if possible.

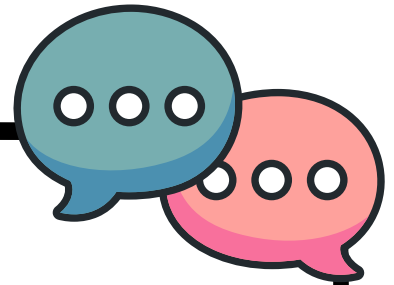
- Do you live in Canterbury?
