



## ARCHERY

Shooting with a bow and arrows, especially at a target as a sport.



## AMERICAN FOOTBALL

A game for two teams of eleven players in which an oval ball is moved along the field by running with it or throwing it



## ATHLETICS

Sports such as running, throwing and jumping





## SWIMMING

The sport or activity of moving through water by moving your arms and legs



## BADMINTON

A game played on a court with light long-handled rackets used to volley a shuttlecock over a net



## BASEBALL

A ball game played with a bat and ball between two teams of 9 players



## BASKETBALL

A game played on a court by two opposing teams of 5 players



## BOXING



A sport in which two competitors fight  
by hitting each other with their hands



CYCLING

The activity of riding a bicycle



CANOEING

The sport or activity of traveling in or  
paddling a canoe



CRICKET

A game played with a ball and bat by  
two teams of 11 players

The sport of riding on a bicycle



DIVING

The activity or sport of swimming under water, usually using special breathing equipment



HORSE RIDING

The sport or activity of riding a horse

The sport of fighting with long thin swords

This sport of a series of races on either purpose-built circuits or closed roads, as street circuits.



GOLF

A game on grass where players try to hit a small ball into a series of holes using a long, thin stick.





## GYMNASTICS

A sport that involves exercises intended to display strength and balance and agility.



## HANDBALL

A game similar to squash in which a ball is hit with the hand in a walled court.



## HOCKEY

A game played on an ice rink by two opposing teams of 6 skaters each who try to knock a flat round puck into the opponents' goal with hockey sticks.



A sport in which two people fight using their arms and legs and hands

## KARATE

A sport, originally from Japan, in which people fight using their arms, legs, hands, and feet.



## ETBALL

A game similar to basketball and mostly played by women.



## SOFTBALL

A game closely resembling baseball that is played on a smaller diamond and with a ball that is larger and softer.



## ROWING

The activity of moving a boat by using oars.



## RUGBY

A sport played by two teams with an oval ball and H-shaped goals.



## SAILING

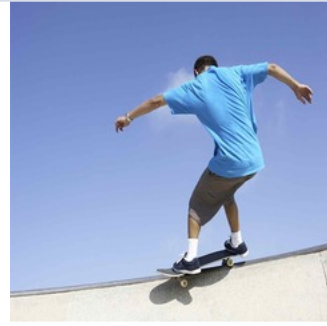
The sport or activity of travelling in or directing a small boat with sails.



## SKATEBOARDING

A street sport, done on a chart, in stairs or other flat surfaces.





## MOUNTAIN CLIMBING

A mountain sport consisting of climbing elevated points for sport, pleasure and research.



## SQUASH

A racket sport played by two (singles) or four players (doubles) in a four-walled court with a small, hollow, rubber ball. The players alternate striking the ball with their rackets, directing it onto the playable surfaces of the four walls of the court.

The sport of riding a surfboard on a wave.



## ENNIS

A game played with rackets by two or four players who hit a yellow ball back and forth over a net that divides the court.



## TABLE TENNIS

A game (trade name Ping-Pong) resembling tennis but played on a table with paddles and a light hollow ball.





## VOLLEYBALL

A game for two teams, usually of six players, in which a large ball is hit by hand over a high net, the aim being to score points by making the ball reach the ground on the opponent's side of the court.



## WATER POLO

A game played in a swimming pool by two teams of swimmers who try to throw an inflated ball into the opponents' goal.



## WRESTLING

The sport of hand-to-hand struggle between unarmed contestants who try to throw each other down.
