





























C- Read the text and pick out information.

Halloween is on ¹the night of October 31st and it's celebrated by many children, teenagers and adults around the world. A lot of the Halloween traditions that we know today began in Ireland. It's a very old tradition. Now, Halloween is very popular all over the United States, Canada and the United Kingdom.

People decorate their homes with pumpkin lanterns called ² jack o'lanterns.

A lot of children and teenagers wear costumes for Halloween. The most popular costumes are witches, vampires, skeletons and zombies.

On Halloween evening, lots of children go trick-or-treating. They dress up in Halloween costumes and go to friends' and neighbours' houses. They say 'Trick or treat!' to get a ³treat, like sweets or chocolate. Sometimes, they visit ⁴haunted houses.

Halloween parties are a lot of fun. There are usually orange and black decorations, like pumpkins, ⁵spiders and bats. The food is often scary too, for example sandwiches that look like witches' fingers or cakes that look like spiders! Children play Halloween games, listen to music and sometimes watch horror movies.
