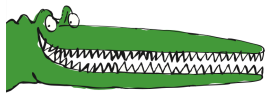

Take part in a Roald Dahl competition. How well do you know Roald Dahl? What about his books (original and French versions)?

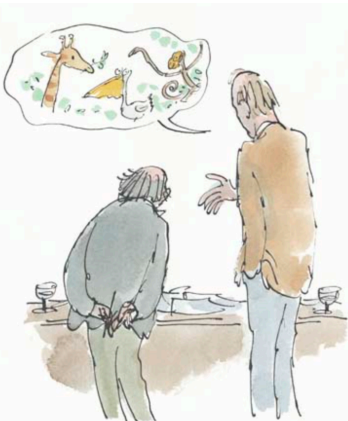
